Plan Projects:

This PEI Plan has 2 projects:

- 1) Yolo Wellness Project
- 2) Early Signs Project

Yolo County Plan Strengths:

- Yolo County's Community Planning Process was inclusive by providing outreach to diverse communities in various settings, including the Russian community, clients and family members, and the Latino community at the farmers' market.
- Yolo County conducted twenty-eight key informant interviews including LGBT and Tribal target populations.
- Yolo County held 11 community stakeholder meetings and 4 focus groups to engage specific targeted ethnic and cultural communities.
- The Wellness Project includes urban and rural children's resiliency programs.
- The expansion of senior peer counselors in Project #1 was considered a strength in the overall Plan.
- The Early Signs Project consists of 2 training teams composed of consumers and family members to serve as instructors for key community agencies and the overall community. This project also includes Crisis Intervention Training for law enforcement personnel and other first responders to crisis.
