This PEI Plan has 2 projects:

- 1) Hayfork and Southern Trinity Health Services (STHS) Primary Intervention
- 2) Challenge Day

Trinity County Plan Strengths:

- The Community Program Planning contacted diverse communities, including Native American groups. They scheduled planning meetings at different times of day and in different locations throughout the County and provided food and transportation as incentives.
- The Plan is responsive to lessons learned from CSS and was very transparent about the challenges a 'frontier rural county' faces.
- The Projects expand services in rural areas, use school sites and FQHC's as natural, non-stigmatizing locations.
- The Challenge Day event will reach a large number of youth and families. This event will also involve teachers, administrators, mental health providers and community leaders.
- The leveraging of resources in this community was outstanding.
