

## Presenters

**Patrick Arbore, MA, EdD** is the Founder and Director of the Center for Elderly Suicide Prevention and Grief Related Services Program (CESP), a program now of the Institute on Aging in San Francisco. Patrick conducts workshops and presents lectures locally and nationally on aging related subjects. He is the author of numerous articles and book chapters on suicide prevention, bereavement, suffering, etc.

**Tonya Fancher, MD, MPH** is the Associate Program Director for the Internal Medicine Residency Program at the University of California Davis Medical Center.
