This test script involves interoperability issues surrounding out-of-county children and youth. Homeless youth appears at a crisis center in a County other than their County of Residence as indicated in the Client's eligibility information.

Key Features of this test script are:

- Search for a Client record
- Add a Client record
- Verify eligibility for services
- Record Rendered Services
- Submit Claim to County of Residence
